Poster Guidelines

Posters are to be presented on Tuesday 7th July 2015 at 3pm. The e-poster session will be held at The Cube, on level 4 of P Block at QUT Gardens Point. The following specific formatting requirements are to be followed by presenters.

Submission deadline

Your final PDF poster file should be emailed to eblip8@qut.edu.au by **19th June 2015**.

File dimensions and formats

Your poster should be provided in a PDF file format and have the correct dimensions. You can create your poster in PowerPoint (provided you use the correct dimensions and saved the file correctly) or in an image editing program such as Photoshop, Illustrator or Corel. Please see the two documents on creating using PowerPoint and Image Editing for further details.

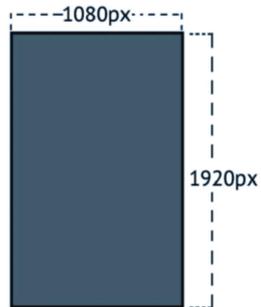
Content recommendations and restrictions

- ✓ Your poster should be a combination of text and static images (photos, diagrams, etc). Video should not be included as the software platform we are using on The Cube cannot support video within posters.
- ✓ You have the option of including multiple pages (up to 4), which you can swipe through on the night. *(To do this please provide 4 separate images)*
- ✓ Keep it simple and concise and engaging. Many posters will be on display, so viewers might only spend one or two minutes looking at your poster.
- ✓ There is no design template you need to follow, so you can determine all aspects of the layout and formatting.
- ✓ Zooming in and out of the posters will not be possible, so make sure the text and graphical elements are big enough to be easily read. We recommend a heading font size of 30–40 and a body font size of 20–30.
- ✓ We recommend you use solid background colours rather than white. The contrast can make it difficult to read text on a white background.

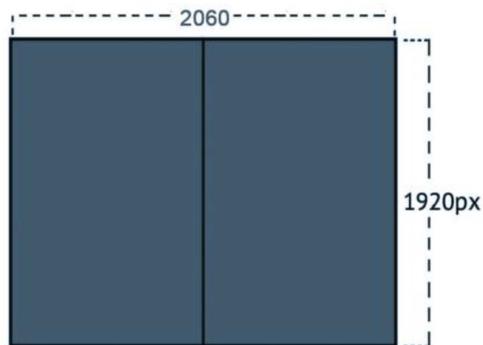
The Poster

There are 3 different types of poster you can choose to display.

1. A single panel poster. 1920 pixels (height) x 1080 pixels (width)



2. A double panel poster. 1920 pixels (height) x 2160 pixels (width)



3. A multi page poster. Four 1920 pixels (height) x 1080 pixels (width) image
